## CTAA Intermediate Co-Ed Soccer Rules

The CTAA Co-Ed Soccer Tournaments follow the FIFA Laws of the Game, which include (or with the exception of) the following:

| Duration of the Match (Timing) | - Round robin games run every 30 minutes. Please ensure that you are ready to go immediately at your start time. There will be no warm-up time given on the field. <br> - The games will be between 25-30 minutes. Game length may vary. The referee begins timing a new game every 30 minutes whether teams are ready or not. |
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| Round Robin Games | - In round robin play, each team will play a total of 4 games against the teams within their division. <br> - Ties will not be broken in round robin games. |
| Substitutions | - Substitutions can be made on goal kicks, after a goal, and any team awarded a throw-in may substitute a player at this time. If a substitution is made, the opposing team may also substitute a player, but only if the awarded team has done so and at the discretion of the referee. |
| Other Important Rules/Information | $-{ }^{* *}$ A minimum of 3 girls must be on the field at all times. If a team is unable to have 3 girls on the field, they will forfeit the game.** <br> - Any player who is given a RED CARD will be out of the tournament for the remainder of the day and not permitted to play again. There will be no appeal. <br> - Slide tackling is not permitted. <br> - There is zero tolerance for player or coach misconduct. <br> Referees have been instructed to issue a yellow card to any player being disrespectful in ANY manner. Please ensure that the proper courtesy and respect is given to all game officials and opponents. <br> - After each game, please ensure your bench is clear and all garbage is cleaned up. <br> - All players must wear proper shin pads with socks to cover. Cleats are recommended, but not necessary. <br> - Transportation to and from the tournament is the responsibility of the school. (Most schools leave it up to the parents to provide transportation). <br> - Coaches will be emailed by 7am if the tournament is being postponed due to weather. It will also be posted on the CTAA website. <br> - Coaches - please ensure you have a way of contacting your players to let them know if the tournament is postponed. |
| Points | - Teams are awarded 3 points for a win, 2 points for a tie, 1 point for a loss. <br> - Playoff positions will be determined by total points. <br> - Ties in the standings will be broken as follows: <br> - If two teams are tied: |
